| Validity | The StartPASS is valid for one calendar year (01.01. - 31.12.) and must be renewed every year. |
| Deadline | The StartPASS can be ordered at any time during the season for competitions of the Swiss Triathlon series (Triathlon / Duathlon / Cross) or Swiss Championships, however, for organisational reasons the order must be placed by 10h00 on the last Friday before the race at the latest. |
| Refund | The amount paid will not be refunded by Swiss Triathlon. |
| Presentation | The StartPASS must be able to be presented (printout PDF or on smartphone). Exception: For competitions of the Swiss Triathlon series (Triathlon / Duathlon / Cross) or Swiss Championships, the annual StartPASS does not usually have to be presented if ordered in good time due to a preceding automatic check. |

| Deadline | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Youth/Youth or National League: Until the registration deadline of the first participation.- Pupils/Regio League: until 3 weeks before the first participation. |
| Code of Conduct | For Swiss Triathlon, the idea of fairness has the highest priority. Before the first registration or participation in the Regio League or Youth League, it is therefore assumed that the "Code of Conduct" has been accepted (for details see conditions of the corresponding series). |
| Refund | The amount paid will not be refunded by Swiss Triathlon. |
